Re: Confidentiality of Map Submitted with Bearkat Renewable Energy Project, LLC Chapter 313 Appraised Value Limitation Application with Glasscock County ISD

To Whom It May Concern:

As an attachment to Bearkat Renewable Energy Project, LLC Chapter 313 Appraised Value Limitation Application submitted to Glasscock County ISD on November 22, 2013 ("Application"), we designated the map attached thereto ("Map") as "Confidential". We submit this letter to comply with the requirements by which both Glasscock County ISD and the Comptroller's office can withhold confidential or proprietary information from public release while the Application is pending. This letter is submitted to identify the documents for which confidentiality is sought and provide the specific reasons, stating why the material is believed to be confidential.

The Map reflects the proposed specific site plan and the location of tangible personal property to be located on real property covered by the Application – all of which continue to be refined. In addition and at this time, disclosure of the Map could be potentially valuable to our competitors and any disclosure could negatively impact the project. The Map is commercially valuable geological or geophysical information regarding the exploration or development of natural resources and is protected from disclosure under section 552.113 of the Texas Government Code.

As required, the Map was submitted as segregated in the application from other information in the application and specifically notated as "Confidential".

It is our intention to complete negotiations relating to both the location of the property and the tangible personal property during the time the Application is pending and understand that Map can only remain confidential and withheld from public release unless and until the governing body of the school district acts on the application.


