



Agency 714 Supplemental Summary of FY '15 Annual Report

The UT-Arlington HUB Program saw a 6.4% increase in spend with HUBs in the Building Construction category. Due to our commitment to increase exposure to HUB vendors, there was a marked difference in the quantity of bids and resulting awards to HUB's over last period. The University is committed to making a good faith effort to increase purchases and contracts awarded to Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) firms and to insure a full and equal opportunity to provide goods and services for the university. We fully expect these participation numbers to increase over the next period for FY'16.

The HUB Program will continue to provide each of our 200+ departments a summary of their HUB participation for the previous reporting period. This summary will reinforce an awareness regarding their role in the overall university performance. It also enables us to advise them on methods for increasing their HUB participation.

The University's HUB Coordinator is given the opportunity to speak at monthly New Employee Orientations to acquaint new hires with the importance of the HUB program. She also participates in pre-bids meeting by supplying sources of HUBs to be contacted for HUB Subcontracting Plans and outreach.

The HUB Coordinator maintains an aggressive outreach program through participation in association and vendor fairs and also utilizes these groups to publicize HUB events.
