Instructions for Completing State Criminal Costs and Fees Report

This report must be filed by the due date even if no payment is due. An amount or a zero (0) must be entered on all lines for Columns 1 and 3.

Column 2 - A service fee may be taken only when the payment is postmarked by the due date. A ten (10) percent service fee applies to Items 1-4 and 6-7. A four (4) or five (5) percent service fee applies to Items 8-10 as indicated. There is no service fee for Item 5, DNA Testing Fee - Juvenile.

Section I (Items 1-3) - Report in a "lump sum" amount, the total court costs collected, based on the date of the offense. Collections will be distributed to the various court costs in effect during each of these periods, based on historical data for that specific time period. Note: Peace Officer Fees, FTA, BB, EMS, DNA, DNA CS, DNA JV, MVF, JPD, STF, JRF, IDF, JS and Time Payment fees should be reported where indicated.

Report REPEALED COSTS - Court costs assessed prior to the repeal of the original statute are still to be collected and reported to the state. *Lines 5 and 7 are no longer assessed as of Jan. 1, 2022. **Lines 11-19 are no longer assessed as of Jan. 1, 2020.

- Item 4 Bail Bond Fee (BB) A \$15 fee is assessed on each surety posting a bail bond for an offense other than a misdemeanor punishable by fine only under Chapter 17, Code of Criminal Procedure. The fee should not exceed \$30 for all bail bonds posted at one time by a surety company for an individual (Government Code, Section 41.258).
- Item 5 DNA Testing Fee (DNA JV) For offenses committed on or after Jan. 1, 2010 only. \$50 or \$34 is due for a child adjudicated of a felony requiring a DNA sample under Family Code, Section 54.0409 or other law. (Family Code Sec. 54.0462) No service fee. (Jan. 1, 2010 Dec. 31, 2021)
- Item 6 EMS Trauma Fund (EMS) A \$100 fee is assessed on offenses in Chapter 49, Penal Code, except Section 49.02 and 49.031, for offenses committed on or after Jan. 1, 2004.
- Item 7 Juvenile Probation Diversion Fee (JPD) A \$20 fee per disposition hearing held. Collected only if ordered by the court and the child, parent or other person responsible for the child's support is financially able to pay it. (Tex. Family Code Ann., Section 54.0411) (Sept. 1, 1987 Dec. 31, 2021)
- Item 8 State Traffic Fine (STF2) Sept. 1, 2019 forward A \$50 court cost shall be assessed on the conviction of any offense under Transportation Code Title 7, Subtitle C "Rules of the Road" (Transportation Code Section 542.4031). Note: State parking and pedestrian violations are included. A four (4) percent service fee is allowed on this fund.
- Item 9 State Traffic Fine (STF) Prior to Sept. 1, 2019 A \$30 court cost was assessed on the conviction of any offense under Transportation Code Title 7, Subtitle C "Rules of the Road" (Transportation Code, Section 542.4031). Only a five (5) percent service fee is allowed on these citations.
- Item 10 Intoxicated Driver Fine Sept. 1, 2019 forward, on conviction of operating a motor vehicle per Penal Code 49.09, a fine of \$3,000, \$4,500 or \$6,000 is assessed. (Transportation Code 709.001) A four (4) percent service fee is allowed on this fund.
- Item 11 Prior Mandatory Costs Report in a "lump sum" amount the total court costs collected for Jury Reimbursement Fee (JRF) (Code of Criminal Procedure, Art. 102.0045, effective Sept. 1, 2005 Dec. 31, 2019) Indigent Defense Fund (IDF) (Local Government Code, Section 133.107, effective Jan. 1, 2008 Dec. 31, 2019) and Judical Support Fees (JS) (Local Government Code, Section 133.105, effective Dec. 1, 2005 Dec. 31, 2019).
- Item 12 Moving Violation Fees (MVF) For offenses committed Jan. 1, 2010 Dec. 31, 2019 only. A \$0.10 court cost is assessed on conviction of moving violations (Code of Criminal Procedure, Art. 102.022).
- Item 13 DNA Testing Fee Felony Convictions (DNA) For offenses committed on or after Sept. 1, 2001-Dec. 31, 2019 only, \$250 is due on conviction of a felon offense listed in the Government Code, Section 411.1471(a)(1).
- Item 14 DNA Testing Fee MSDM & CS (DNA & CS) For offenses committed on or after Sept. 1, 2001-Dec. 31, 2019 only, \$50 on the conviction of a misdemeanor offense listed in Section 411.1471(a)(3). For offenses committed on or after Jan. 1, 2010-Dec. 31, 2019 only, \$34 is due on placement of a person on community supervision, if the person is required to submit a DNA sample under Section 11(i), Article 42.12.
- Item 15 Truancy Prevention and Diversion Fund (TPD) A \$2 court cost assessed on convictions of all offenses except pedestrian or parking of a motor vehicle. Local jurisdiction may retain 50% of funds collected for purpose of operating or establishing a juvenile case manager program. (Code of Criminal Procedure Art. 102.015, Sept. 1, 2019-Dec. 31, 2019).
- Item 16 Failure to Appear/Pay Fee (FTA) A \$30 administrative fee assessed on a failure to appear or satisfy a judgment for certain violations (Transportation Code, Section 706.002) only if a city has contracted with the Department of Public Safety. Two-thirds (\$20) is sent to the state. One-third (\$10) is retained locally. Only through Dec. 31, 2019.

Item 17 - Time Payment Fees (TP) - Report 50 percent of any portion of the \$25 fee collected from a person who pays any part of a fine, court cost or restitution on or after the 31st day after the date on which a judgment is entered assessing the fine, court cost or restitution (Local Government Code, Section 133.103), effective Jan. 1, 2004 - Dec. 31, 2019.

- Item 18 Judicial Fund Constitutional County Court A \$15 court cost shall be assessed on each conviction of any criminal offense if the court participates in the supplemental salary program (Government Code, Sections 26.006, 51.703) through Dec. 31, 2019 only.
- Item 19 Judicial Fund Statutory County Court A \$15 court cost shall be collected on each conviction of any criminal offense in statutory county court (Government Code, Section 51.702) through Dec. 31, 2019 only.

Section II: As applicable

- Item 20 Peace Officer Fees Report 20 percent for actions by state officers only (Code of Criminal Procedure, Art. 102.011).
- Item 21 Motor Carrier Weight Violations (MCW) Remit 50 percent of the fines collected on violations of Transportation Code, Section 621.506. Only the fines for Over Allowed Gross Weight single axle, tandem axle or gross weight and Over Allowed Gross Weight-Zoned violations should be reported. For offenses committed on or after Sept. 1, 1999, which occurred within 20 miles of an international border, the entire fine shall be deposited in the municipal or county treasury for the purpose of road maintenance.
- Item 22 Driving Records Fee (DRF) Remit fee assessed by the judge when they order a driving record from DPS for deferred disposition cases (Code of Criminal Procedure, Art. 45.0511, c-1).
- Item 23 Non-Suspension Fine (NSF) A \$100 fine shall be assessed on a defendant convicted of a misdemeanor drug offense, when defendant's driver license is not suspended (Code of Criminal Procedure, Art. 102.0179, B).
